

## Children and Play

Please keep track of your children and monitor their safety. Children are welcome to play in the empty half of the sanctuary, but please do not play with any sports equipment before the service and please do not go near any audio-visual equipment at any time. You are also welcome to make use of the playground outside with parental supervision.

## Nursery and Preschool/Kindergarten Areas

Children under three are welcome in our worship service or in the nursery area. They may be checked into the nursery before Sunday school and checked out at the end of the worship service, or they may be checked in for any part of that time that is helpful.

Children from age three to the completion of their kindergarten year participate in our worship service until the beginning of the sermon. At that time, these children are welcome in our worship service or in the preschool/kindergarten class. Visiting families will need to take their child to the class to sign them in; regularly-attending families may sign their children in before the service begins or when class begins.

## The Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is open to all who have been united to Jesus Christ in repentance and faith. Have a representative of your group or family take enough cups and bread for your group, and then return to your seat. There are also prepackaged bread and cup on the table in the hall. The church body takes the elements together at the same time. After the service, please dispose of empty cups in the wastebasket at the back of the room.

## Offering

Giving is an act of worship that acknowledges God as the rightful owner of all we have and all we are. We all should give cheerfully and generously for the advancement of God's kingdom and the glory of his name. We hope that as you get to know Redeemer you will decide this is a church that makes much of Jesus and makes disciples, and that you want to partner with us in the work of the gospel.
