

Children and Play

Please keep track of your children and monitor their safety. Children are welcome to play in open areas, but please do not allow your children to run near or around people who are not playing.

Nursery and Preschool/Kindergarten Areas

Children under three are welcome in our worship service or in the nursery area. They may be checked into the nursery before the service and checked out at the end of the worship service, or they may be checked in for any part of that time that is helpful.

Children from age three to the completion of their second grade year all participate in our worship service until the beginning of the sermon. At that time, these children are welcome in our worship service or in the appropriate class. Visiting families will need to take their child to the class to sign them in; regularly-attending families may sign their children in before the service begins or when class begins.

The Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is open to all who have been united to Jesus Christ in repentance and faith. Have a representative of your group or family take enough cups and bread for your group, and then return to your seat. There are also prepackaged bread and cup available. The church body takes the elements together at the same time. After the service, please dispose of empty cups in the wastebasket at the back of the room.
